Welcome CSU Prac Student

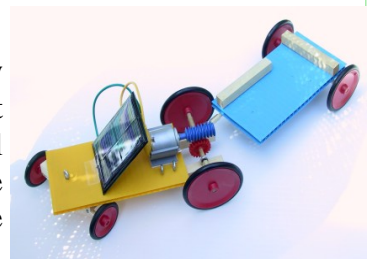
Today we welcomed Ms Jacinta McLean to the K/1/2 room. Ms McLean, a third year student, will be working at our school for the next 3 weeks.

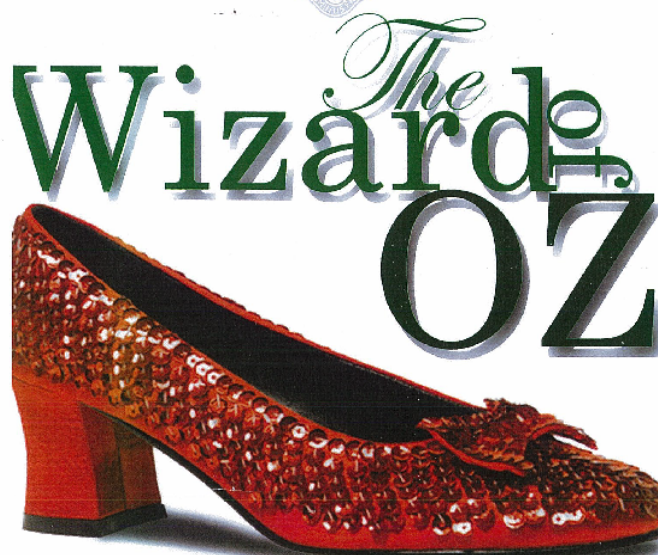
