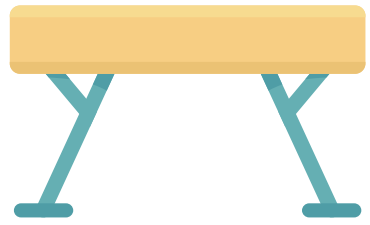
Students were so pleased to take the cover off the sandpit and open the “Cubby Cafe” for business at the end of the proceedings.
